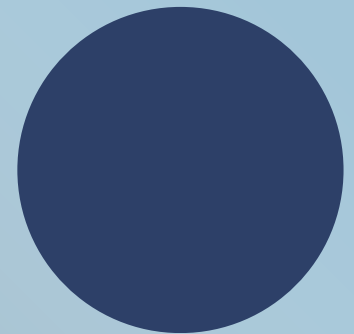

Sister Zeph the founder and chairperson of the ZWEE foundation is a revered figure in education, women's empowerment, climate advocacy, and interfaith harmony. As the Founder and CEO of the ZWEE Foundation and Evaz Ethical clothing brand, she profoundly impacts disadvantaged communities. Notable accolades include the Bioneers Change Makers Award, Lynn Syms Global Prize from World Pulse, and Gold Medals for her work showcased in the documentary "Flight of the Falcons" and "Book of Humanity" by kar-E-Khair Pakistan.

With dual Master's degrees from the University of Punjab in History and Political Science, she represents Pakistan globally.

Sister Zeph holds affiliations with esteemed bodies such as the Swedish Institute, Ifa, and the Network for Religious and Traditional Peacemakers. She's a World Pulse Ambassador, and World Literacy Foundation Ambassador, and completed programs funded by the European Union, fostering interreligious dialogue.

During the COVID-19 response, Sister Zeph's leadership earned appreciation from US Aid and Faiths4Vanninces. Her notable milestones include graduating from Kaiciid, receiving the Minority Women's Leadership Award from Punjab's Governor, and being a finalist for the Women Changing the World Award. 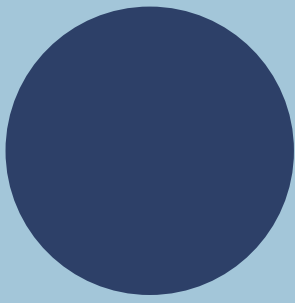

# Message From The Executive Director

## Dear Friends & Supportes

As a 13-year-old girl, I was a dreamer with aspirations of becoming a lawyer like Asma Jahangir from Pakistan. I often dressed up as Benazir Bhutto, our former prime minister. I was an avid debater and writer, focusing on stories that highlighted social issues.

My mother, like many mothers in my country, often reminded me that one day I would get married. However, I couldn't shake the feeling that my purpose in life was greater than marriage. Deep down, I believed there was more to my journey.

I was a sensitive soul, and one particular incident altered the course of my life forever. I left school in the 7th grade and vowed never to return. A deep sense of humiliation haunted me for days. I shut myself away, feeling as if my heart was withering.

One day, I stood on the teacher's chair to address my classmates as if I were the teacher. When my actual teacher discovered this, she berated and humiliated me in front of my peers. Her hurtful words, combined with the mockery of my classmates, left me in tears.

In that moment, I made a life-changing decision to leave school. My dreams seemed to vanish, and my parents urged me to enrol elsewhere, but I refused.

Despite leaving school, I never stopped learning. I began studying independently at home without formal tutoring. Simultaneously, I embarked on a mission to provide girls with the respect and love I had lacked. I started visiting homes in my village, crafting and distributing pamphlets to promote free education. I walked from village to village, tirelessly urging parents to send their daughters to my school, promising to teach them English for free. My mother and I visited homes every Sunday, but no one joined initially.

At just 13, people dismissed my efforts as naïve. Yet, I persevered, determined to spare others from the hardships I had faced. I vowed to create a school without corporal punishment, where learning was engaging and enjoyable.

In the beginning, I had only one student, and we held classes outdoors. Even now, we have no building—our roof is the sky. In summer, we study under the sun; in winter, under blankets; and when it rains, classes pause.

At 16, I completed my matriculation and secured a job as a telecom receptionist. My \$15 monthly salary funded school supplies. I later earned a master's degree in Political Science in 2010 and am pursuing another in History, all through self-study.

To date, I have taught around 500 girls. My school now has three programs: the Women Learning Center, which trains 20 students in stitching, embroidery, and soft skills; Formal Education, with 100 students; and an English language course for 15 girls. I also run a beauty salon training center, where 20 girls learn hairdressing and bridal makeup. Next month, I will launch a computer learning center to connect girls globally.

I use my salary to pay competitive wages to staff at Zephaniah Free Education. I also manage the World Wide Women's community page, run my own page, "Zephaniah Free Education," and contribute blogs addressing women's issues. Currently, I am studying journalism and producing community dramas to promote peace, respect for women, and the value of education.

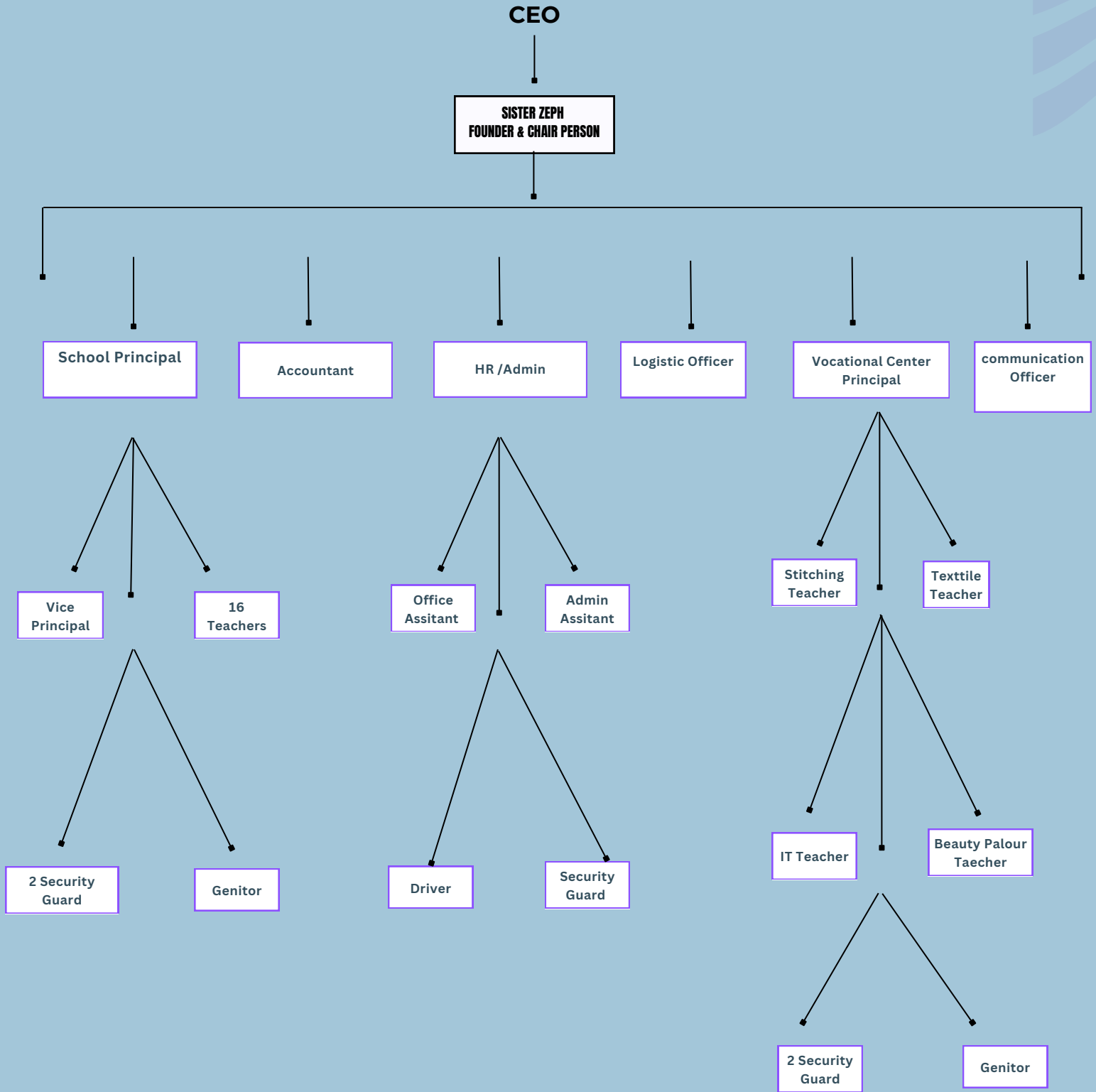
My teams feel like family, and my co-workers provide moral support. Friends on Facebook inspire me to explore new ideas.

In my region, women face lifelong suffering—mental and physical abuse, lack of education, child marriage, and honor killings. Witnessing their plight strengthens my resolve. I believe education and awareness are the keys to change. My vision is a world where every girl is educated, empowered, and protected. I will continue this work for the rest of my life.

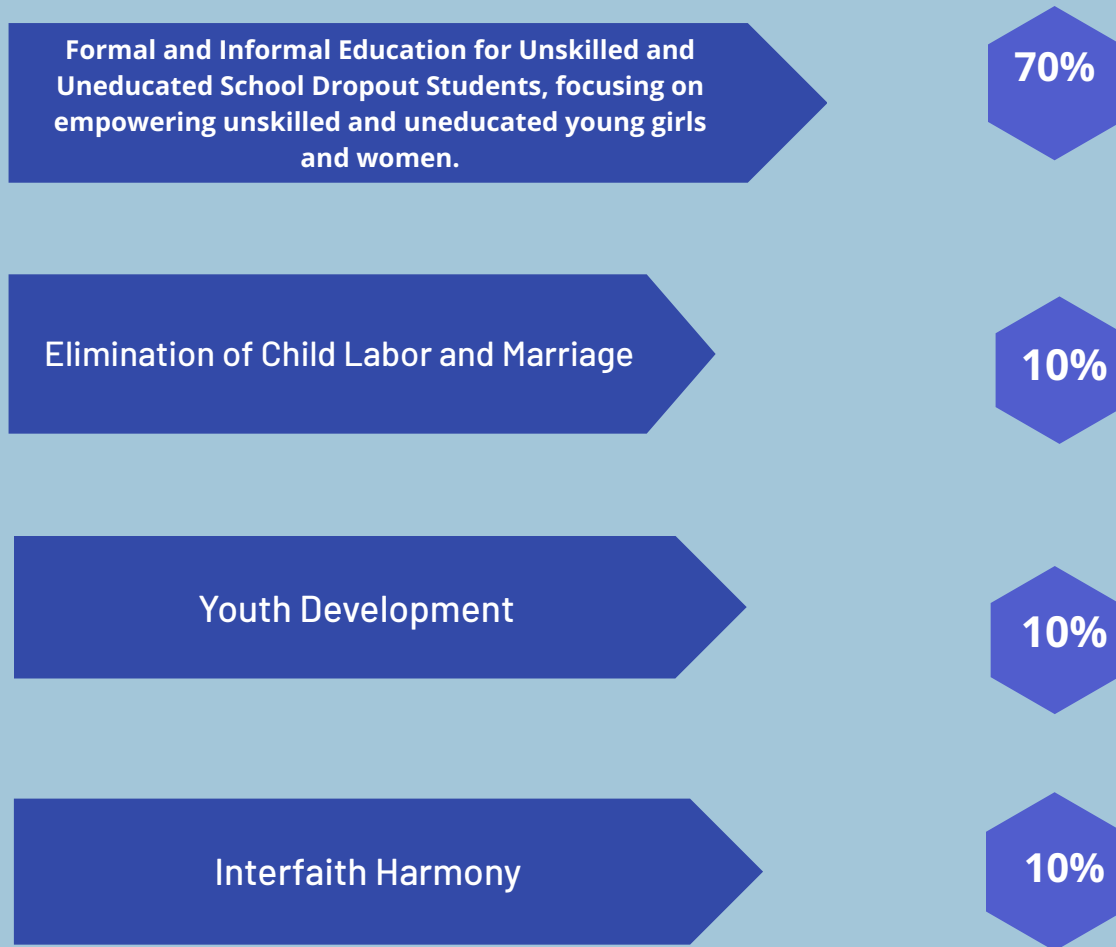

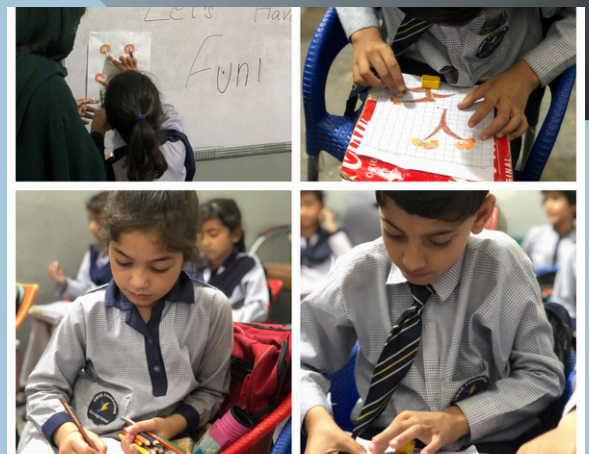


## 23rd March Celebration at ZWEE Foundation
